16 hectares 80% clay 20% clay/limestone/sand 95% Merlot 5% Cabernet Sauvignon Located on the heights of Saint-Christophe-des-Bardès, the vineyard is part of the Saint-Emilion appellation. It benefits from the ocean and temperate microclimate of the region, very favorable to wine culture. The vines of the field were planted in 1945. The exceptionally high rate of clay in the composition of its land promotes the absorption of minerals and nutrients by the plant, allowing the obtaining of a particularly fruity balanced wine. The Merlot, renowned for the roundness, the structure, the intensity and the richness of the fruit it brings, coupled to the Cabernet-Sauvignon which strengthens complexity and structured character, offers a balanced wine, both very round, structured and fruity.
