

Jonathan Maltus does not have the profile that one could expect from a "winemaker" in Bordeaux, since he found his place in the "garage" movement of the 1990s in Saint-Émilion, proving that he had aTaste quite pronounced for the terroir to make wine in a 15th century castle. The dome was imagined by Jonathan Maltus and designed by the award -winning architect Lord Norman Foster. This is how the winegrower meets architecture, both visionaries. The building may be the latest, but it has become, thanks to its cellar and its wines, a central element of the landscape. He joined the most sought-after wine club in the region and Jonathan's "avant-garde" techniques are adopted throughout Bordeaux and beyond. It would be the greatest expression of Cabernet Franc of a Bordeaux wine and, while traditional Bordeaux castles mix grapes from their entire vineyard, the dome represents the terroir in its most authentic sense, Being a "unique grape" wine.
