The origins of this place date back to the 17th century, where it is said that a counselor by Louis XIV had the castle renamed and awarded him the name of "Trianon" in tribute to Versailles and the King of France. Our story, shaped over the centuries and rewritten two decades ago, is that of the vision of a man and a devoted team which made it possible to revive this magnificent property of its magnificent property.
