Large works have been accomplished both in the vineyard and in the cellar to restore this historic property bought by our family in 2001. Located east of the appellation, its terroir reveals all the finesse of the Merlot, king's grape of theright bank. According to the legends, this castle was originally the lair of a war and unscrupulous Hobereau, which owed its nickname "the black" to its armor and its night abuses. It was there that he lived with his henchmen, winegrowers or soldiers during the day and brigands the night. The family reserve is the great wine of this property: a work of goldsmith in the vineyard and a drastic selection of the most beautiful grapes for a production of only a few barrels. This confidential cuvée embodies the devotion of our family to this exceptional terroir.
