HAUTE VALEUR ENVIRONNEMENTALE

Located 3 km southwest of the village of Saint-Emilion and 500 m to the east of the village of Saint Sulpice de Faleyrens, one of the 8 municipalities constituting the jurisdiction of Saint-Emilion, the Château Croix de Bertinat includes today 9.5 hectares of vines in AOC Saint-Emilion and Saint-Emilion Grand Cru, a winemaker and breeding cellar, a tasting room with a breathtaking view of the vineyard and the hill of Saint-Emilion. Our terroir composed mainly of serious, which is rare in the appellation and which is conducive to the production of high quality wines with silky tannins and harmonious aromas.
