HAUTE VALEUR ENVIRONNEMENTALE

The vine is planted on a silt-argilet soil with a basement of limestone molasse. Merlot 80%, Cabernet franc 20%, Vines have an average age of 35. We have chosen to plant the vine since 1983 with a density of 5500/hectare. Our size method, developed in collaboration with the world champion (Michel Duclos), aims to help the vine develop its natural defenses, and thus lead to a significant drop in treatments. In addition, we note the significant development of plant variety and insects in our vineyard. We only use organic fertilizers. Vinification is carried out in Epoxy ceded cement tanks. Each tank has its own temperature regulation system and its micro-oxygenation station. Breeding in French oak barrels for 12 months. We focus our efforts to offer you balanced and elegant wines each year.
