Large works were accomplished both in the vineyard and in the cellar to restore this historic property bought by our family in 2001. Located east of the appellation, its terroir reveals all the finesse of the Merlot, a king's grape on the right bank. According to the legends, this castle was originally the lair of a war and unscrupulous Hobereau, which owed its nickname "the black" to its armor and its night abuses. It was there that he lived with his henchmen, winegrowers or soldiers during the day and brigands the night.
