Since its creation and the acquisition by François and Maria-Dolorès Linard in 2001, the Claymore vineyard has developed and has acquired over time, a notorious place in the Lussac Saint-Emilion appellation. Using a small versatile team, François and Maria-Dolorès have gradually restructured the vineyard, modernized the cellar and shaped wines in their image, while respecting traditions and the terroir.
