AGRICULTURE BIOLOGIQUE

Located in the town of Lussac, the Perrière rose is one of the oldest properties of the appellation. Its history began in the 12th century when the Countess of Castillon had the Cistercian abbey of Faize to the Artigues of Lussac built a few kilometers from the Perrière rose. It is for the richness of its history but also its exceptional limestone clay terroir that Jean-Luc Sylvain fell in love with this atypical property and acquired it in 2003. He then undertakes major renovation works, storage buildings and vineyards. Château La Rose Perrière is engaged in organic farming and officially obtained its organic farming certification in July 2023 for its future vintage 2023.
