HAUTE VALEUR ENVIRONNEMENTALE

This old vineyard, which dates back to the 15th century, is located on a clay-limestone coast, a few kilometers northwest of Saint-Emilion. The vineyard of nearly 40 ha, straddling the two Puisseguin-Saint-Emilion and Montagne-Saint-Emilion appellations, has benefited in recent years from innovative transformations to bring grapes to maturity and optimal quality: increased surface area, stripping, clarification, reasoned protection. The care brought to the quality of the grape continues during the vinifications during which the sorted harvest is conveyed in the small thermo-regulated tanks of the restored and enlarged cellar in 1999. Vinifications are done in separate lots and this individuality will be kept all along. Long vinifications and farming in barrels.
